DIRECTIONS

From Nampa — Hwy 45 S to Hwy 78.
About 5 miles S of Murphy, TURN
RIGHT on Silver City Road. (big sign).

From Grandview — NW on Hwy 78
about 26 miles to Silver City Road.
TURN LEFT.

Travel SW 5.8 miles to a T-junction.
TURN RIGHT onto Road 430 (toward
Diamond Basin). Travel 3.2 mi. to
Diamond Basin Well. TURN W (left)
on Road 400. Camp on right .7 mi.
